<p>Boyd Family Perpetual Trophy</p>	<p>Most successful male or female at SISA carnivals 13 years and over <i>(This result is obtained from the YASC swimmer who achieves the highest point scores at SISA carnivals for the season excluding SISA Champs)</i></p>
<p>Carole Clark Perpetual Trophy</p>	<p>Most successful para (multi-class) male or female at SISA carnivals <i>(This result is obtained from the YASC swimmer who achieves the highest point scores at SISA carnivals for the season excluding SISA Champs)</i></p>

<p>The Young Hotel Perpetual Trophy</p>	<p>Encouragement award – male (decided by the coaching team) for their persistence and consistency in the development of the necessary skills to participate in swimming</p>

<p>Coaches Awards (trophy only)</p>	<p>The award is not intended to be the club's Fairest and Best swimmer but is chosen by the team coaches based on the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Regular attendance and 100% effort at training and carnivals. * Team Player - puts team before self * Accepts feedback and puts it into practice * Happy to do whatever is asked of them & doesn't question coach's decisions * Encourages and supports their teammates * Always respectful to teammates, officials and opposing teams * Consistent sportsmanship * Standout improvement * Professionalism – punctual, communicates, wears the YASC uniform with pride, prepared * Always strives to "be the best you can be"

<p>YASC Monthly Medal (medal only)</p>	<p>Awarded to the male & female swimmer with the highest point score achieved for all strokes from Friday night club swims for the months of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - October/November - December - January - February - March
<p>Representative Plaque</p>	<p>A plaque issued to swimmers who swim individual events at representative level for YASC (i.e. Country Jnr/Snr State, Nationals).</p> <p>The badges on these plaques will be updated each year by the Club for any representative level swimming for YASC</p>
<p>Representative Medals for Relay Teams (medal only)</p>	<p>A medal issued to swimmers who swim in relay events at representative level for YASC (i.e. Country Jnr/Snr State, Nationals).</p>
<p>YASC Special Recognition Trophy (trophy only)</p>	<p>This trophy can be awarded to acknowledge the achievements of one of our swimmers for the season (may not necessarily be for events swum for the YASC but their achievements can be attributed to the pathway from YASC to other representative levels of swimming) <i>This award is determined by the President</i></p>
<p>SISA Speedo Sprint Final Medal (medal only)</p>	<p>Awarded to YASC swimmers who qualify & compete at Speedo Sprint Finals</p>
<p>Brophy Representative (medal only)</p>	<p>Awarded to YASC swimmers who are invited to represent SISA at the Brophy Invitational Meet</p>
